

Poland, ICVS'2004 – technical info

Technical info related to ICVS'2004 in Poland is as follows:

1. Sample design

Poland used random individual personal addresses sample drawn from official national registration PESEL. The sample was also stratified by local area.

2. Method of interview: face to face

3. Response rate

General response rate was 71.5%:

- number of persons drawn: 7600
- errors in addresses: 590,
- total sample size is 7010 (7600-590)
- number of interviews done: 5013
 - o number of refusals, persons not available, etc.: 1997
- response rate: 71.5% (5013/7010)
